- Entries for all categories can only be submitted through <u>www.creativewritingawards.co.uk</u>.
- Entries must be in PDF or .doc (Word) format.
- This competition is open to children living in Dumfries & Galloway. If your postcode begins DG, you are eligible to enter.
- The competition launches on Tuesday 10 March 2020.
- The closing date for entries is 5pm on Sunday 26 April 2020. Any entries submitted after this time will not be judged.
- The competition is open to any child aged between 5 and 18 on the day the competition launches: Tuesday 10 March 2020.
- Children should enter the appropriate category for their age as at Tuesday 10 March 2020.
- Entries must be entirely the child's own original work.
- All entries are judged anonymously, and the name or age of the child must not appear on the document or in the document title.
- Entries may be submitted in English or Scots.
- Only one entry is permitted per child.
- Parents should check the email address carefully before submission as this is the only contact information requested. You will receive a confirmation of your entry by email. - The winning children will be contacted by email on Friday 15 May 2020.
- The judge's decision is final. The winning entry plus two runners up in each category will be displayed at Wigtown Book Festival.
