

# WFC Covid Action Plan

There are no current Covid-specific government restrictions in place, however, caution is still advisable.

In order to provide a safe and welcoming environment to authors, audience, volunteers and staff at this year's festival Wigtown Festival Company (WFC) will ensure the following steps are in place during the 2022 festival. - 1) Hand sanitiser stations will be placed at the entrance of each venue and will be regularly topped up.
- 2) Where necessary, windows and doors will be opened between events to ensure that there is adequate ventilation.
- 3) Masks will be available at each venue for the general public, staff and volunteers to make use of.
- 4) We advise that anyone with symptoms of COVID-19 or who has been in contact with someone with COVID-19 tests before coming to an event.
- 5) Audience members can approach staff or volunteers at any time with questions concerning these measures.
- 6) The public will be advised - through signage and volunteer stewards - of the above recommendations.

Staff and volunteers are to be aware of the following advice:

- 1) This year there is no formal requirement for volunteers to be vaccinated or to take regular lateral flow tests. However, in line with Scottish Government regulations, WFC recommends this.
- 2) Lateral flow tests and masks are available from the Box Office, should you require them.
- 3) If you test positive for COVID-19 after being on the festival site, please inform a member of staff in the office by calling 01988 403222, and give them a list of close contacts.
